General Supplies for all grades 6-8

- Flash Drive
- Tissues- 2-3 boxes per student
- Lysol/Clorox Wipes- 2-3 per student (PLEASE NO BABY WIPES)
- Hand Sanitizer (one larger one with a pump)
- Pencils (be sure to STOCK UP)
- Pens, preferably blue, black, and red (suggest a pack of each one)
- Highlighters (4-5 different colors)
- Glue sticks (feel free to stock up)
- Colored Pencils
- Scissors
- Loose-leaf paper and graph paper
- Scientific calculator (example: any of the TI-30X calculators)
- Protractor (keep this SAFE because you will need it in the spring for math)
- Ruler (keep this SAFE because you will need it all year)
- Binder with 6 two-pocket folders - feel free to get a few extra in case they are needed for specials
- Headphones (corded are preferred, but must have 3.5mm jack - Lightning/Apple will NOT work)
- Mouse - USB or bluetooth - with scroll wheel
- Backpack with laptop sleeve or a backpack AND a neoprene carrying case (for transporting chromebooks between classes)
